

## Manpower Survey Results in April 2022

- **Total employment decreased by 25,000(-0.22%) in April to 11,415,000; moreover, it also decreased by 109,000(-0.95%) when compared with that of the previous year.**

--Employment in agriculture increased by 1,000(+0.13%); by contrast, the industry sector and the services sector decreased by 8,000(-0.20%) and 18,000(-0.26%) in April, respectively.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the industry sector and the services sector decreased by 13,000(-2.39%), 40,000(-0.98%) and 57,000(-0.81%) in April, respectively.

- **The unemployment rate declined by 0.04 percentage points to 3.62 percent in April; the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate declined by 0.02 percentage points to 3.68 percent.**

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate declined by 0.02 percentage points in April.

--The number of unemployed persons was 429,000 in April, a decrease of 6,000(-1.39%) and 6,000(-1.42%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

- **Labor force participation rate declined by 0.03 percentage points to 59.16 percent in April; however, it rose by 0.01 percentage points from that of the previous year.**
